

## How Does LBUSD Manage Potential COVID-19 Cases?

### Detection

LBUSD plans asymptomatic COVID-19 testing of unvaccinated students during the first three weeks of school. In addition, students found to have COVID-19 symptoms when entering campus or during the school day will be sent to the COVID-19 Assessment Response and Evaluation (CARE) Room. A staff member will contact the parent/guardian to pick up the student right away. Each site will have a CARE Room staffed with designated, trained staff.



### Investigation

If a student or staff member tests positive for COVID-19, the COVID-19 Site Response Team is notified. LBUSD has designated employees to support COVID-19 protocols and management. An investigation includes complete contact tracing of all those who may have been in close contact. The person who tests positive is asked to isolate at home.

### Notification

All close contacts are notified of possible exposure to COVID-19 within 24 hours. The California Department of Public Health defines close contacts as less than six feet of spacing for more than 15 minutes in a 24-hour period.



### Home Quarantine of Close Contacts

The current home quarantine recommendations for unvaccinated close contacts, or for unvaccinated students who have not had any symptoms are as follows:

Quarantine can end after day 10 from the date of the last exposure without testing, or after day 7 if tested after day 5 from the date of the last exposure, and the test is negative.
